- Teaching staff will work Monday to Friday including a mid-week excursion.
- All other staff will work 6 days per week and will support excursions that take place on the days that they are working.

Plan and deliver a Team Project Challenge, in your field of expertise. PGCE and/or experience in teaching in the specified knowledge area.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEACHERS

Plan and deliver English lessons, based on our curriculum, in an engaging way. CELTA/Trinity Cert. TESOL (or Accreditation UK recognised equivalent) or PGCE in English or MFL.

ACTIVITIES LEAD

Plan and lead afternoon and evening activity programme, sports and excursions. Experience in delivering activities to groups of children. Expertise in any sports coaching advantageous.

ACTIVITIES

Deliver the scheduled activities, including sports, group activities and excursions. Qualification in first aid and lifeguarding or expertise in any sport coaching advantageous.

HOUSE STAFF

Live in the boarding houses. Provide a safe and warm environment for students, with physical and mental wellbeing a priority. Support with delivery of activities and meals.
