



## Physical Education Placement Student

### RESPONSIBILITIES

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The Physical Education Student Placement will:

- Be part of the Sports Department, working flexibly to support the Director of Sport.
- Assist in implementing the curriculum
- Assist in the planning and preparation of courses and lessons
- Teach, according to their educational needs, the pupils assigned to you, including the setting and marking of work to be carried out by the pupils in school and elsewhere.
- Assessing, recording and reporting on the development, progress and attainment of pupils.
- Have the ability to be flexible and willing to cover lessons
- Instill and maintain a high standard of dress and behavior from pupils and staff at fixtures and during sports sessions, ensure that kit is consistent and correct. Ensure that a record is made of incorrect kit and the pupils form tutor informs the child's parents.
- Assist in a well-balanced competitive fixture programme
- Promote good sportsmanship and conduct for both staff and pupils across all aspects of sport at Westonbirt.
- Promoting the general progress and well-being of individual pupils and of any class or group of pupils.
- Attend assemblies, registering the attendance of pupils and supervising pupils, whether these duties are to be performed before, during or after school sessions.
- Providing guidance and advice to pupils on educational and social matters.
- Making records of and reports on the needs of pupils.
- To be aware of and comply with Health and Safety policies, legislation and best practice.
- To work within school procedures and codes of practice.
- To undertake such other duties as are required by the Headmistress.
