

# FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027

## Registration Fee

A Registration Fee (non-refundable) of £120 is payable to reserve a place for the pupil at the school, subject to availability of a place and to meeting the entry requirements.

## Deposit

Once a place has been offered, a deposit of £500 is required to confirm that the pupil will be joining Westonbirt Prep. All deposits are returnable once a pupil completes their studies at the school and all outstanding financial obligations have been discharged.

## School Fees

Fees are payable in three equal amounts, termly in advance, on or before the first day of each term. School fees cover the normal curriculum. The fees above are inclusive of £540 per term for books, stationary and catering.

The following, where applicable, may be charged to a pupil's account as an Extra: extra subjects; after-school activities; school transport; examinations; excursions; medical treatment. The Board review fees annually and there will be reasonable increases from time to time. Late payment charges will be levied on all outstanding accounts not fully paid by the first day of term.

We accept Childcare Vouchers and Tax Free Childcare payments towards the boarding component of fees and for voluntary extras provided outside the school day when delivered on the school site.

**A full term's written notice to the Head is required to change from boarding to day status, reduce boarding nights, or to remove a student from the school and a penalty of one term's fees will apply for any removal without this notice.**

## Fee Remissions for Westonbirt Prep

### Sibling

When one or more siblings attend Westonbirt Schools simultaneously, a reduction in fees of 5% is made for the second and subsequent siblings after any reduction for Scholarship, Bursary or other provision.

### Forces

Children of serving members of HM Forces are eligible for a reduction in fees of up to 10%, subject to parents' circumstances.

Fee remissions are not applicable to children attending Westonbirt Nursery.

### Advance Payment of Fees

The School will accept the payment of a lump sum to cover fees for two years or more. Please contact the Finance Department ([finance@westonbirt.org](mailto:finance@westonbirt.org)), for more information.

### Voluntary Extras

A full terms notice is required to discontinue a voluntary extra. This must be in writing to the Head. If not received a terms charge will be made in lieu of notice.

### Early Years funding for Reception-aged children under 5

Should a parent wish to use funded hours only, they would come into school between 12.40pm and 3.40pm, 5 days per week. Lunch is not included in this period, as it falls into the non-funded part of the day. Should a parent wish to use funded-hours only, they should contact the Admissions Team.

When a child is only registered for the above funded hours, the registration fee will not be charged, and the deposit will be refunded at the end of their first term. This applies when the child is only registered for funded sessions, without any additional chargeable costs (such as lunch, clubs, school bus or additional activities), otherwise the above registration and deposit arrangements apply.
